








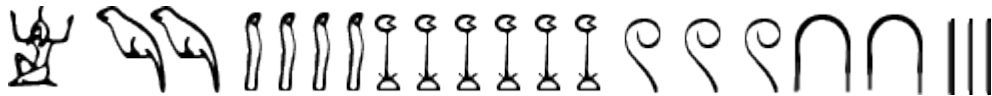
EGYPTIAN NUMERALS

The Ancient Egyptians had symbols for numbers. See if you can read the example below after studying the list of number signs.

1,246,323

Numbers precede the noun when they are this long. Only numbers under 1000 come AFTER the noun.

Amount of wheat harvested

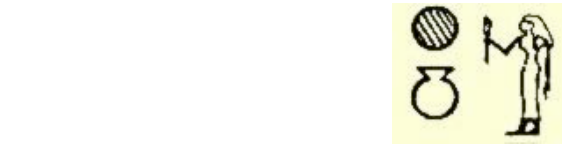
